



Guidelines for Foreigners visiting Lorion Telecom India for Trainings

- 1) All foreigners seeking admission should make an advance payment of training fee of \$500 (Five Hundred US Dollars only) through online transfer. The remaining balance amount of the training fee should be paid at the time of registration at Lorion Telecom – Hyderabad.
- 2) Once the Visa is granted by the Indian Embassy, the candidate should send a scanned copy of Visa issued and of Air tickets to Lorion Telecom.
- 3) The candidate has to take direct arrival tickets to Hyderabad and should NOT land in any other Airports while arriving here in India for trainings.
- 4) Lorion Telecom will take the responsibility of picking you up at the Airport and drop you at the place of stay and hence all your travel plans including date of arrival, flight information, place of stay (assistance can be given in this regard) etc. have to be intimated in advance.
- 5) The candidate should make return travel arrangements made in advance.
- 6) After arrival in India, if the candidate desires to visit other cities in India should inform the management of Lorion Telecom about the city, dates of visit, place of accommodation etc.
- 7) All foreigners should submit the original passport at the time of admission at Lorion Telecom which will be returned back on completion of the training.
- 8) Candidates desirous of pursuing other technical trainings in India apart from Training at Lorion Telecom should obtain permission from Lorion Telecom and should intimate the schedule of trainings and training center. Once admitted into other trainings, the candidate should furnish Bonafide certificate for the duration from the respective firm imparting training.
- 9) The candidates need to cooperate with the management of Lorion Telecom in abiding to the laws as prescribed by Indian Government in ensuring your smooth stay in India.
- 10) If any of the information furnished by the candidate is found to be false, or if the candidate is found to be working against the sovereignty of India, Lorion Telecom reserves the right to cancel the admission and take measures as necessary.
